We will host an *Ash Wednesday Service on March 6th at 6:00 p.m.* Ash
Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent. Lent is a time when many Christians prepare for Easter by observing a period of fasting,

repentance, moderation and spiritual



discipline. Ash Wednesday emphasizes two themes: our sinfulness before God and our human mortality. The service focuses on both themes, helping us to realize that both have been triumphed through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. During Ash Wednesday services, the minister will lightly rub the sign of the cross with ashes onto the foreheads of the worshipers. The use of ashes as a sign or mortality and repentance has long history in Jewish and Christian worship. Historically, ashes signified purification and sorrow for sins.

Note from Pastor Cowser

"Giving It Up"

Just like a deer craves streams of water, my whole being craves you, God. Psalm 42:1 (CEB)

We have much to be thankful for as a congregation, but we also have room to grow. The people in our church and our community



are hungry and thirsty for something deeper in their lives. I know I am. I pray this Lenten Season will be a time for us to make changes in our lives so that we can make more room for God and others. Therefore, our theme for Lent 2019 will be "Giving It Up." The Season of Lent is 40 days, not including Sundays, which begins with Ash Wednesday, a day of repentance and recognizing our mortality in light of a gracious and merciful God, on March 6th and ends on Holy Saturday, the day before Easter.

Many of us give up things for Lent, but we don't give it up just because it's cute or because we want to try a new diet, but we give up things so that we can make more room for God. If you're like me, every now and then, you have to evaluate your life and see what things you need to let go of in order to hear from God more clearly and experience Him in new and renewed ways.

For the next several weeks, I will be preaching and teaching on some of the things that God wants us to give up - control, power, expectations, burdens, popularity, and enemies. On Easter, we will conclude with "Giving Up Death" - John 20:1-18. The main reason I am writing is so that this theme will begin to saturate our hearts and minds. Simply put, let all that we do this season from our worship, meetings, meals, studies, media, and activities for children, youth and adults be centered on giving up so that we can make more room for God in our lives. I'm asking that each of you begin to use your sphere of influence to help me minister this theme to the people of God in this season.



We will continue the tradition of collecting a special sacrificial offering above our regular giving to the church on Easter Sunday. Offering gleaners/envelops are available in the Welcome Center.
